Transkripce čtvrté části Velebného svity Jiří Procházka Prahou - Rackový waltz vychází z kopie originálního zápisu uložené v pozůstalosti K.V. v Muzeu hudby v Praze. V přepisu bylo užito běžně užívané řazení nástrojů se saxofonovou sekcí v horní polovině partitury a žesti umístěnými pod saxofony. Aranžmá vzniklo pro Velebného natáčení s Jazzovým orchestrem československého rozhlasu (JOČR) , který hrál v netypickém obsazení saxofonů 1x alt sax, 3x tenor sax a baryton sax. Přepis byl proto upraven pro klasické big bandové obsazení - 2x alt sax, 2x tenor sax a baryton sax. V rámci transkripce bylo na některých místech sjednoceno frázování a dynamika a byl zvolen moderní zápis harmonických značek.

V úvodu a v závěrečné části jsou 3. a 4. trombon napsány o oktávu níže než je napsal Velebný, protože všechny trombony jsou psány unisono v rozsahu do c². V běžných big bandech však hráči na 3. a 4. trombonu tímto rozsahem zpravidla nedisponují. Obdobně jsou ve stejných místech upraveny party 3. a 4. trubky.

Originální nahrávku celé svity nahranou Karlem Velebným spolu s JOČRem vydal Radioservis v roce 2019 na albu Schola ludus.




